New Haven Urban Resources Initiative (URI) is a local non-profit/Yale University partnership that runs **Community Greenspace**, a program that enables community volunteer groups to beautify their neighborhoods' streetscapes, parks, and/or vacant lots. Most Greenspace groups meet weekly at a regular time and location.

You are invited to join any of the groups listed on the reverse side and get community service credit for your time and contributions. Activities may include tree planting and gardening (weeding, mulching, watering, and planting perennials and shrubs), path building, and other infrastructure projects. If you get involved early in the summer, you may be able to help set summer goals and brainstorm beautification plans for your community. Groups set their own goals and work together to reach them over the course of a couple months each summer.

Work gloves and tools are provided. Please wear closed-toe shoes and clothes that can get dirty. Some groups meet rain or shine, so dress appropriately.
